Summer is traditionally a time of rest. Days are longer and the hot weather invites us to slow down, sit in the shade, and stay cool. Yet, because of modern conveniences, we can ignore or even miss this call of summer to rest. We can also miss the call of Psalm 131 to find calm and quiet in our souls in God's presence and to lay our head on God's shoulder like a child upon his/her mother's breast.

Yes, we are occupied with many things. Yes, there are both greatly important and marvelously wonderful things in our lives that call for our attention. And yet, we need rest. Do not occupy yourself too severely with the many chores and delights of this world and forget to find times to rest. Calm your soul. Find

respite in God's Word. Seek tranquility in God's creation or the spaces in which you find restoration. Breathe deeply and place your head on God's shoulder.

Hope in the Lord from this time on and forevermore.
